Travel Directions

Use Google Maps for your directions, type in 'The Duke Marloth Park' for the most accurate direction.

FROM JOHANNESBURG

Travel from Johannesburg on the N4 to Witbank and follow the N4 through to Middleburg-Machadodorp, take the left fork after the Machadodorp toll and go through Schoemanskloof. Then travel through Nelspruit to Malelane. After Malelane you travel for 25KM, turn left at Marloth Park. Please note this is a 5KM gravel road. Turn left at 'Kudu Road' and drive for about 1 minute until you see the sign the Duke.

FROM CROCODILE BRIDGE GATE

After leaving the park, you drive 4KM and turn right on to the Tenbosch road. Go straight on this road for 10km and enter the Marloth Park gate. Drive 13KM until you reach 'Kudu Road'. Turn right and drive 1 minute until you see the sign of The Duke.

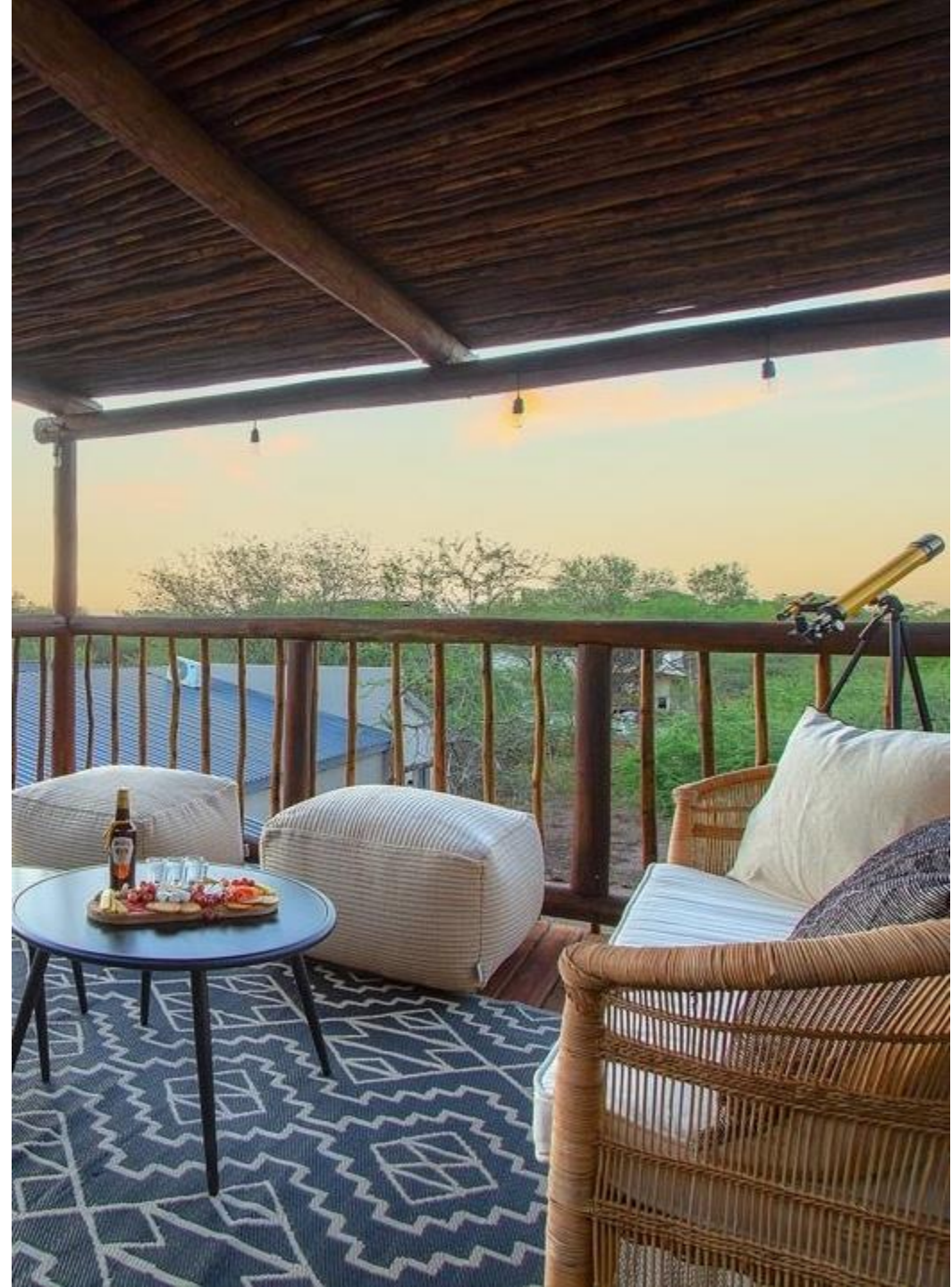
Please throw your waste bags in the garbage cages (located at the start of the driveway) to avoid any insects coming into the house.

Swimming Pool

The large pool of 9 by 3 is for your private use. The pool is cleaned before your arrival, but for your comfort the automatic vacuum cleaner will be in the pool. If you would like to unplug it, you can easily do so by unplugging the hose in the filter. We provide a pool net behind the braai to remove bugs and other unwanted guests in the pool.

At no time is there a lifeguard on duty, you (the guest) are responsible for the safe operation of the pool and are responsible for all persons using the pool during your stay. By making use of the pool area, you automatically accept the rules and terms & conditions and you indemnify the owners from any and all liability to property, or personal injury or death to, any third party, resulting from the use of the pool or pool area.

Please find the full waiver which is automatically accepted when you make use of the pool (area) at the end of this booklet or on www.mrlth.com.



Boma and outdoor kitchen

Firewood and charcoal can be bought at the stores in the Bushcentre, the entrance gates of Marloth Park and are also widely available in Malalane and Komatipoort. Gathering wood in Marloth is prohibited. In the outdoor kitchen cupboards, barbecue tools and a fire extinguisher can be found.

Please make sure all fires are properly monitored & extinguished. Never leave a fire unattended, since the bush can be very dry.



Alarm System

For your safety, the villa is equipped with an alarm system and CCTV-monitoring linked to an armed response unit of iSecure. Please ensure to close all windows, lock the door and activate the alarm when leaving the property.

- Press the white button **once** to activate and **twice** to deactivate the alarm.
- The red button is for emergencies, including medical situations.

Should the alarm go off, iSecure will visit the property to check if all is well. In the event of a false alarm (don't worry, it happens!), please contact iSecure as soon as possible by phoning or Whatsapp them on 061 527 9330 (international: +27 61 527 9330)



Fire Alarms & Extinguishers

Every room in the house is equipped with a fire alarm. In the event of a fire, contact the fire department immediately by phoning 112. Fire extinguishers can be found next to the braai and in the kitchen (next to the trash bin). In the bottom drawer next to the fridge you can find a first aid kit and a fire blanket.



Safe

Inside the closet of the bedrooms, there a security safe where you can put your most valuable belongings. The hosts will provide you with the security code.

Water and Electricity

Please consider the environment when using water & electricity. These resources are scarce in South Africa. Loadshedding is common in Marloth Park. These are periods where the electricity grid is overloaded and therefore not functioning. The villa is equipped with a back-up water tank and electricity system to supply you with three hours of power (at normal/average usage) should loadshedding occur.

Some shops and restaurants are closed during this time so it is wise to install the mobile app 'ESP' for you to track when loadshedding will be in the area. Marloth Park and surroundings are situated in area 8.



Baby bed

The villa comes equipped with a baby bed for your convenience. If you would like to use these, please inform the host prior to your arrival.



Cleaning Service

Upon your arrival our housekeeping team has deep cleaned the entire villa. Need a clean mid-stay? We can provide an additional full service clean of the property at an additional charge of R350. (Subject to availability)

Please wash all dishes and/or place the dishes within the dishwasher before departure. Guests are not required to strip bed linen from beds. Please leave used towels in bathrooms.

If the property is left in an excessively messy condition excess cleaning fees will apply



Airconditioning

The villa is equipped with air conditioning to keep you comfortable during your stay. As part of our continued efforts in sustainability we ask you to turn the air conditioning off when a room is not in use and keep all doors and windows closed whilst the air conditioning is on.

Don't leave the house while the aircondition is still on, as the compressor is prone to overheating which can lead to dangerous situations like fire.



Kitchen appliances

The kitchen is fully equipped with an oven, microwave, toaster, airfryer, kettle, stove, fridge and freezer. It offers two coffee machines, one for nespresso capsules and one for grounded coffee.



Towels & Bedding

Pool towels and bath towels are provided. If you require additional towels or linen during your stay, please contact our hosts at location.



Look-Out Tower

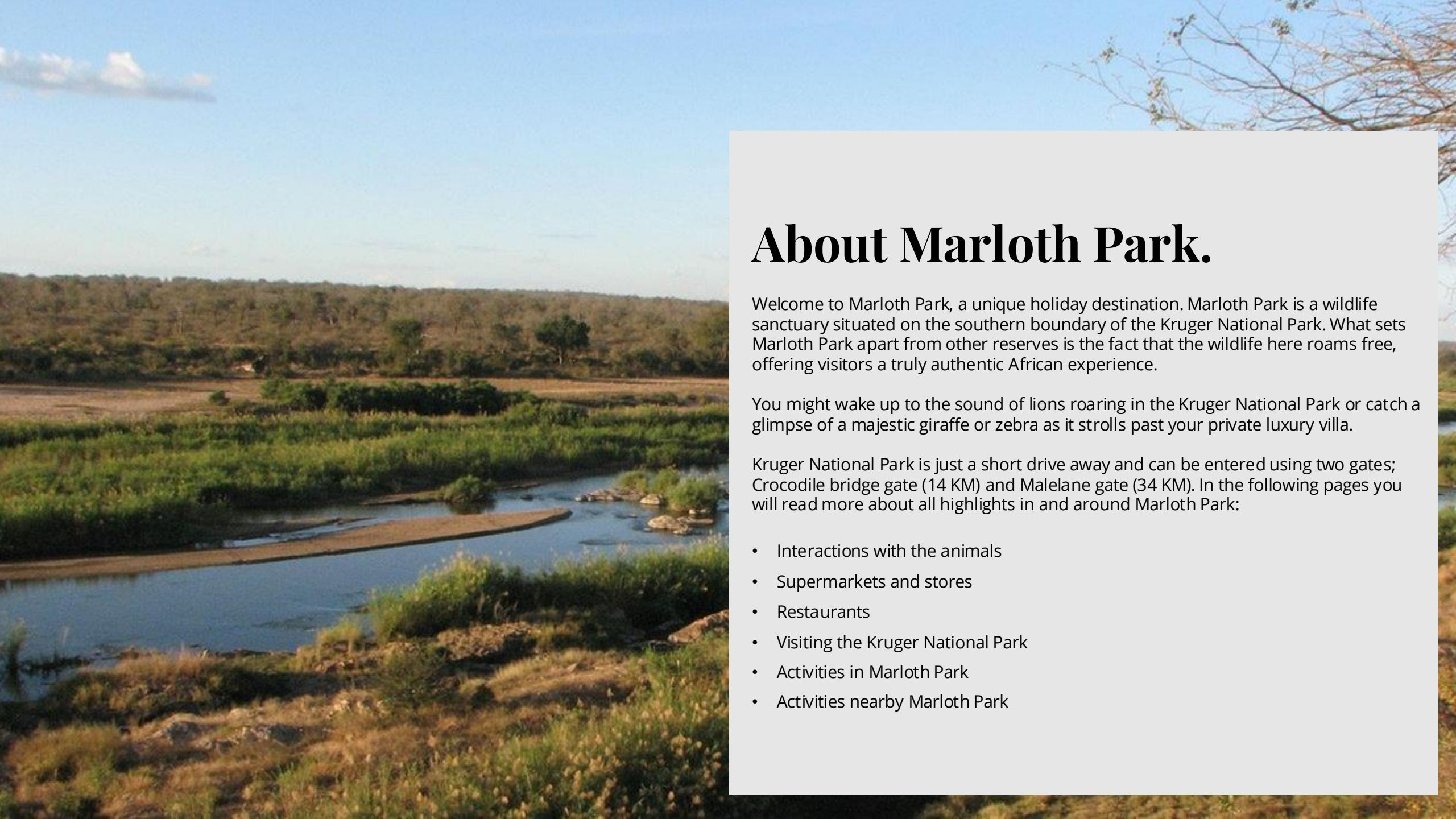
Entering the look-out tower is at your own risk. Please don't exceed the maximum weight limit of 500 kilo (about 6 people).

Rules & regulations.

By making a booking at The Duke. and/or staying at The Duke., you signify that you have read the contents of the indemnity /disclaimer form and that you understand and appreciate the nature and effect(s) hereof and that same constitutes a binding agreement. Please find the full waiver which is automatically accepted when you enter Marloth Park and/or the property at the end of this booklet or on www.mrlth.com

- 1 BREAKAGE:** It is the guest's full responsibility to acknowledge any notable damage to the property within 2 hours of entry into the property. If breakage or damage happens during your stay, you can be charged a fee for replacement.
- 2 PARK RULES:** Since Marloth Park is a conservancy; no loud noise, including music, is allowed. Please consider your neighbours as noise tends to travel further in the bush than in an urban area. After 20:00 noise complaints are strictly enforced by the police department and fines are hefty. Speeding limits are 50km/h on paved roads and 30km/h. Please don't walk in the dark for your own safety.
- 3 SMOKING AND FIRES:** There is strictly no smoking inside the property. Please make use of the ashtrays provided when smoking outside since the bushveld around can be very dry and flammable. Open fires are not allowed outside of the Boma/Braai areas. Please make sure your ashes are cooled off before throwing them in the garbage bag.
- 4 ELECTRICITY AND ALARM:** Please turn of the airconditioners, lights and all other small electricity items to save energy. Once you leave the house, please turn on the alarm for your own safety.





About Marloth Park.

Welcome to Marloth Park, a unique holiday destination. Marloth Park is a wildlife sanctuary situated on the southern boundary of the Kruger National Park. What sets Marloth Park apart from other reserves is the fact that the wildlife here roams free, offering visitors a truly authentic African experience.

You might wake up to the sound of lions roaring in the Kruger National Park or catch a glimpse of a majestic giraffe or zebra as it strolls past your private luxury villa.

Kruger National Park is just a short drive away and can be entered using two gates; Crocodile bridge gate (14 KM) and Malelane gate (34 KM). In the following pages you will read more about all highlights in and around Marloth Park:

Interaction with animals

Our goal is for you to have a pleasurable experience exploring everything Marloth Park has to offer, but we also want to ensure your safety during your visit. To achieve this, we kindly request that you comply with the following rules in order to keep you and the animals around Marloth Park safe.

- **Feeding the animals**

Game feed/pallets are available for purchase at Daisy's Den in the Bush Center. You can also feed the bushbabies bananas by putting it on the platform in the tree behind the boma Do not feed the animals any other foods as this can cause harm to them.

- **Stay cautious**

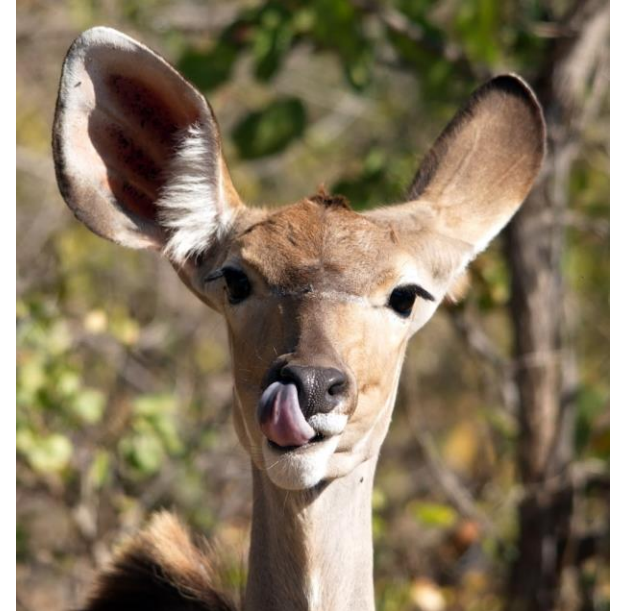
Animals roam freely in Marloth Park. Leopards, snakes, spiders and plains game are frequent visitors, so always be vigilant and cautious. Please close all doors and windows to keep wildlife out of the property. Don't walk after dark.

- **Snakes**

If confronted by a snake, please stay calm and move several steps away from it. In most cases it will move off and be of no threat to you. If you encounter a snake in the villa, please don't try to catch or kill it, that's how you get bitten. Call Juan's rescue centre via 060 665 5000 to remove the snake, they will relocate it.

- **Baboons**

Baboons can cause a lot of problems. Please lock the doors and windows, don't leave food unattended and close the curtains when leaving the house. Never feed these animals, this can lead to dangerous situations for both the animals and humans.



Supermarkets and shopping.

You can stock up groceries at Malalane or Komatipoort SPAR. For basic groceries, nice meat and curious, Marloth Park has a few nice shops.

The Bush Centre

This small shopping centre is conveniently located along the Olifants Drive. Here you will find a lovely butchery named Wild Butchery. For groceries you can visit the Ingwe Supermarket and Game, Animal & Bird feed can be purchased at Daisy's Den. There are ATM's from FNB & ABSA and a laundromat is also present.

Marlothi Shopping Centre

Only a few hundred meters from the Bush Centre. In 2024 a SPAR and SPAR liquor has opened. This small shopping center also comprises of a gas station, carwash, nail salon, post-office, curios shop and (take-away) restaurant The Tin Shack.

Komatipoort

Komatipoort is only 17 kilometers away from Marloth Park and has all conveniences you can expect from a small town. Fast food is available in the form of KFC, Debonairs, Steers, Fishaways & Wimpy. Fuel is widely available at BP, Caltex & Engen. Other services include pharmacies, tire shops and ATM's.

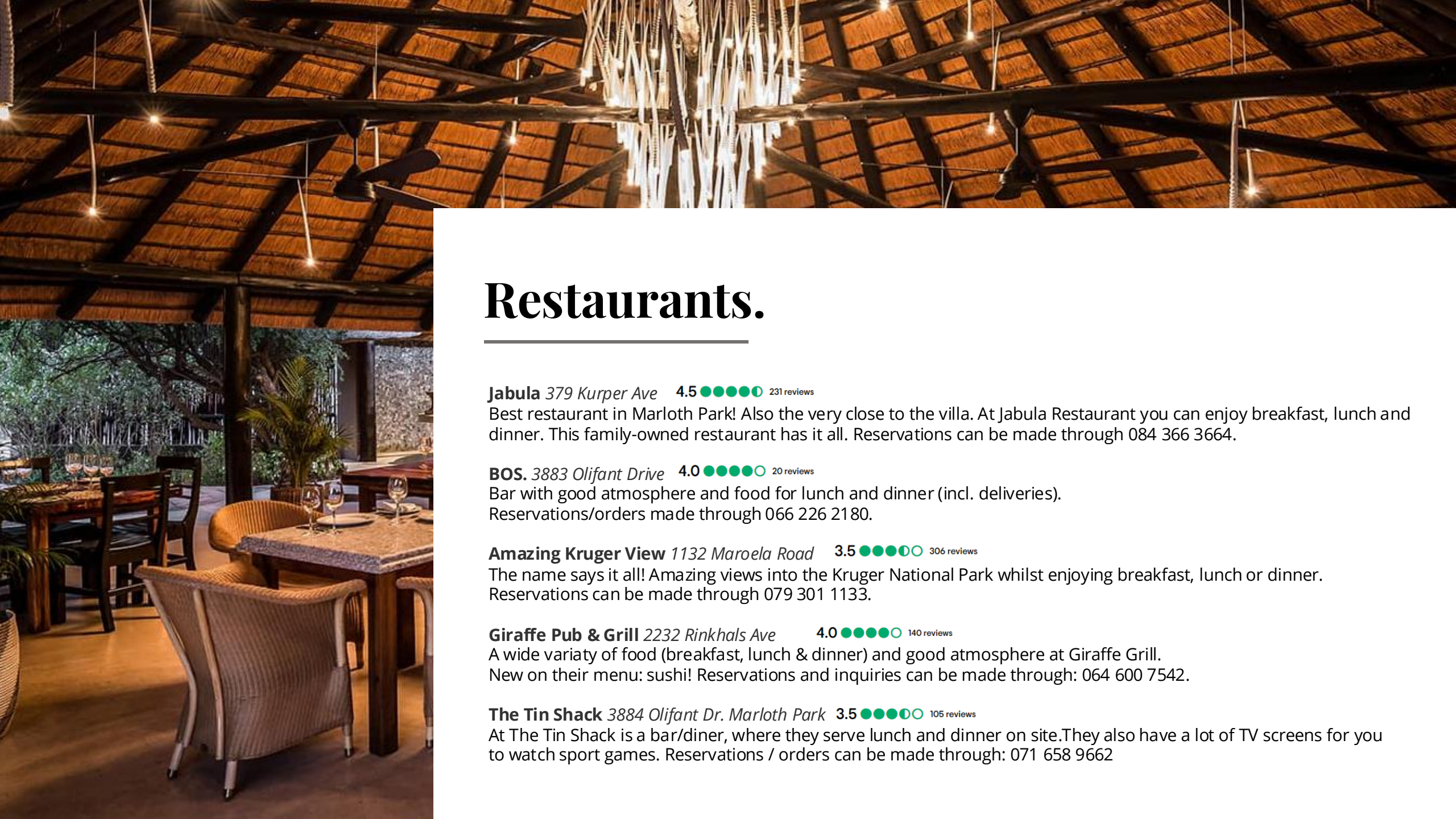
Marula Padstal

A nice stop between Marloth Park & the Crocodile Bridge Entry Gate into the Kruger National Park is Marula Padstal. A cute little curios-shop where you can buy curios or a quick snack and drink. Ask the friendly owner for a "Koeksister" cookie and be ready to be amazed.

Crocodile Bridge Gate & Camp

The Crocodile Bridge entrance gate to the Kruger National Park is only 14 kilometers from Marloth Park. At the entrance to the park, you will find multiple curio shops, a small supermarket, an ATM and a Total gas station. Tip: Buy a map of the park in the park-shop that includes an animal-checklist. This way you can keep track of all the amazing sightings you are going to experience!

Self-drive

A Self-Drive Safari gives you the freedom to drive yourself around the Kruger Park in your own vehicle and it gives you flexibility and the thrill of spotting wildlife at your leisure. Almost all roads in the park are accessible by 2WD cars.

You can buy your tickets to Kruger National Park at the reception at all gates, please don't forget to bring your ID or passport. If you are planning to visit more National Parks during your stay in South Africa, buying a Wild Card may be the most economical option.

Lionspruit Private Game Reserve

Located in the heart of Marloth Park, the famous Lionspruit Private Game Reserve can be found. Four of the Big 5 can be found in Lionspruit: Buffalo, Lion, Leopard, and Rhino. The only-one missing is the elephant, due to the relatively small size of the reserve (1500ha). There are bird hides and picnic/braai spots within the reserve.

The entrance to the reserve is located at 1085 Wildgoose Street where the entrance fee of ZAR 120 per vehicle is payable.

The roads vary in condition throughout the year and during rainy season a 4x4 can be recommendable.

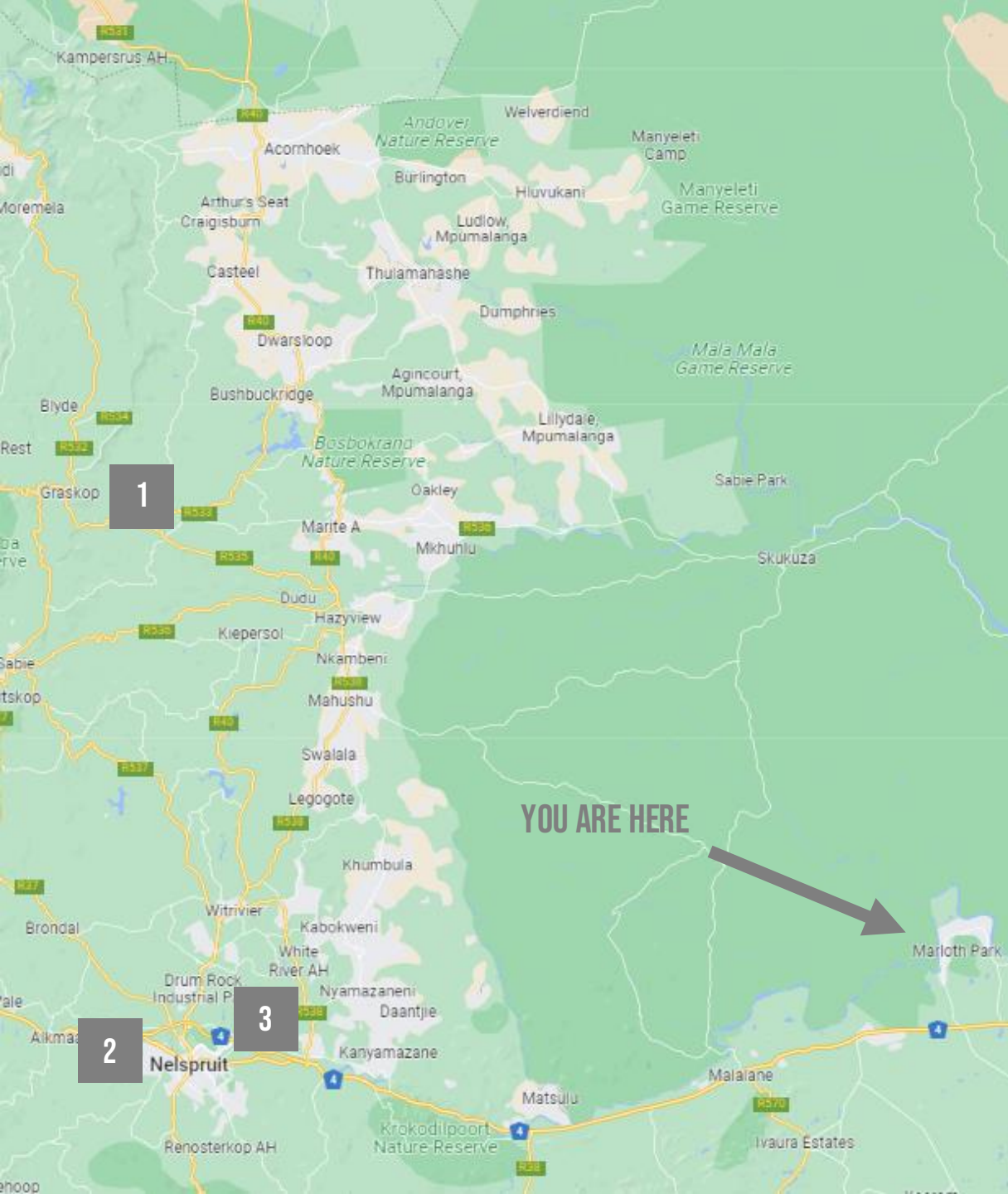
Visit eSwatini (Swaziland)

Lowveld Botanical Garden

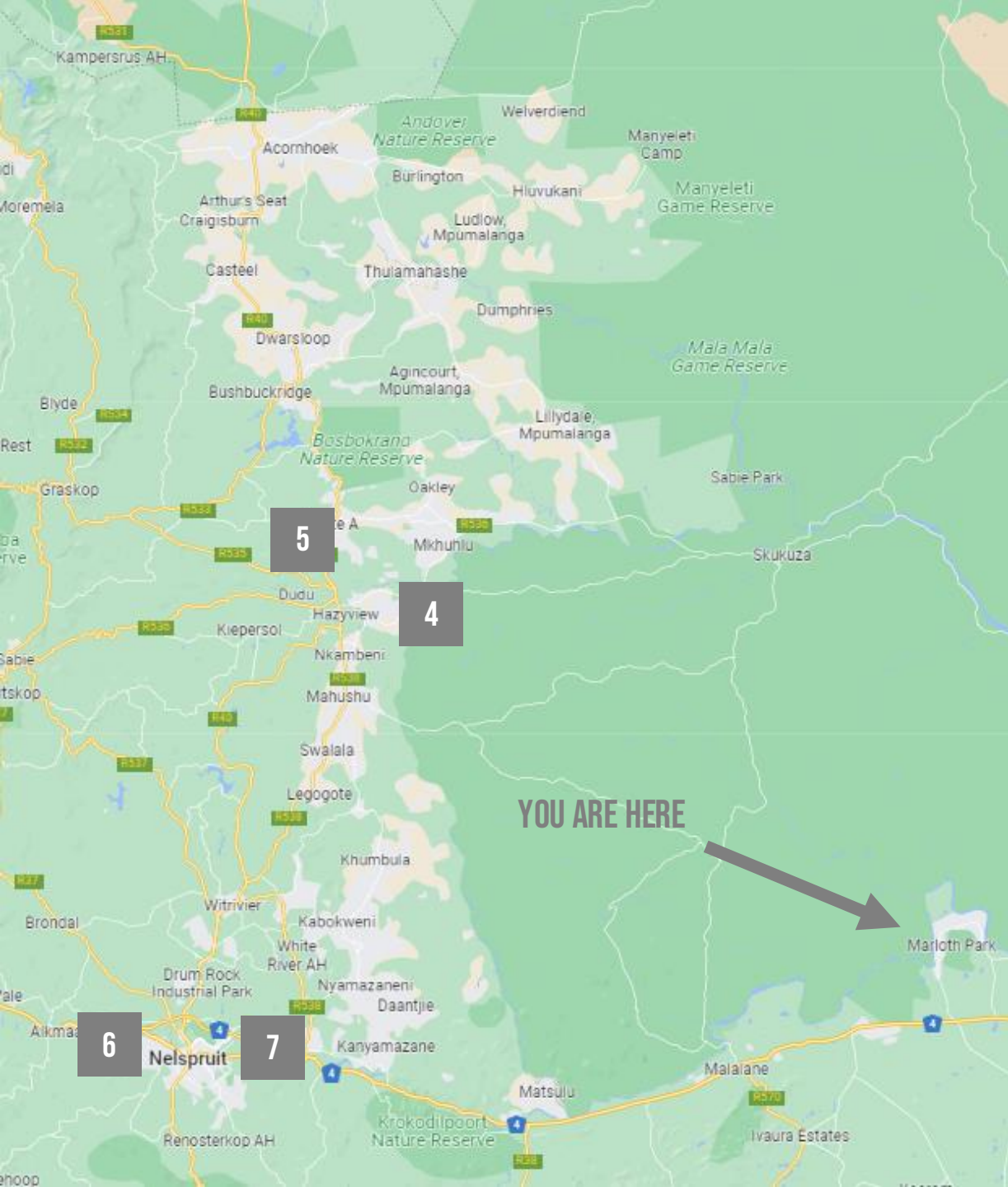

INDEMNITY / DISCLAIMER MARLOTH PARK CONSERVANCY AND THE DUKE.

Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement

By making a booking at The Duke., entering the property and/or staying at The Duke. you signify that you have read the contents of this indemnity / disclaimer form, that you understand and appreciate the nature and effect(s) hereof and that same constitutes a binding agreement, and that, by appending yourself hereto, you hereby confirm that all terms and conditions shall be interpreted and take effect according to the laws of South Africa and the courts of South Africa shall have sole jurisdiction in respect of any claims which may arise.

1. You are entering a wildlife reserve, to wit the Marloth Park Conservancy ("the reserve"), which you understand is situated in a malaria area and where an abundance of species of wildlife roam free and of their own accord;
2. You are fully aware that by entering the reserve, you will be participating in activities in and around the reserve, including, without limitation, in and around the villa area, which activities include, without limitation, the viewing of wildlife, either on foot or from open or closed vehicles, moving about over rough terrain, making use of ramps and stairs and other facilities including, without limitation, the swimming pool, which activities may be inherently dangerous and which activities require that you exercise reasonable care;
3. You fully acknowledge that by participating in activities you may be exposed to various risks of harm, and agree that you are entering the reserve and participating in any and all activities, at your own risk;
4. The reserve, Marloth Park Conservancy and MRLTH. and their related or inter-related companies, corporations, trusts and / or associations, their directors, shareholders, members, agents, employees, representatives, insurers and the relevant landowners, do not accept any liability for any harm of whatsoever nature, suffered by you or your guests, including, without limitation, -
 1. any loss of and / or damage to, any property;
 2. any sickness, illness and / or infection caught, contracted and / or which developed, etc.; and / or
 3. any injury to, or death of, any person; arising from whatsoever cause, including, without limitation, arising in the course of your visit or stay at the reserve, including, without limitation, in any of its lodges, or as a consequence of your participation in any activity whatsoever, including, without limitation, tours and excursions, within or outside of the boundaries of the reserve, and whether or not due to negligent, grossly negligent or wilful acts or omissions;
5. You hereby expressly, unconditionally and without reservation, indemnify (and / or undertake to indemnify) the reserve, Marloth Park Conservancy and MLRTH. and their related or inter-related companies, corporations, trusts and / or associations, their directors, shareholders, members, agents, employees, representatives, insurers and the relevant landowners, and hold them harmless (or undertake to hold them harmless) and absolve them, in full, in respect of any harm, of whatsoever nature and arising from whatsoever cause, suffered by you or any member of your party, including, without limitation, the harm and under the circumstances, referred to or contemplated in clause 4 above;

You further hereby waive and abandon any claim/s, which you, your dependents or executors, trustees or curators may have, at any time, against the reserve, Marloth Park Conservancy and MLRTH. and their related or inter-related companies, corporations, trusts and / or associations, their directors, shareholders, members, agents, employees, representatives, insurers and the relevant landowners;
7. insofar you made a booking, stayed at The Duke. and/or read and accept this document in our representative capacity on behalf of any person, including, without limitation, minors, the elderly or persons with any disability, you hereby confirm that you are duly authorized to do so and that there is no lawful impediment which exists and which precludes you from doing so.

SWIMMING POOL WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM THE DUKE.

Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. BY MAKING USE OF THE POOL FACILITIES AT THE DUKE., YOU CHOOSE TO WAIVE CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE.

By choosing to use the pool facilities, you recognize and fully understand that:

- At no time is the pool supervised or a lifeguard on duty
- You (the hirer) are responsible for the safe operation of the pool facilities and are responsible for all persons using the pool facilities during your hire period
- The use of the pool facilities during your hire period involves a number of risks, including but not limited to:
 - The risk of injury or death as a result of possible malfunction of pool equipment during hire;
 - The risk of injuries or death resulting from slips, trips and falls in the pool area;
 - The risk of injuries or death resulting from the lack of pool supervision;
 - The risk of injuries or death as a result of running, jumping, diving or other similar actions;
 - The risk of other injuries or death resulting from any other actions in the pool and surrounding areas.

You recognize and fully understand that the above list is not an exhaustive list of all possible risks, and only provides examples of risks that could possibly occur whilst using the pool facilities.

In exchange for The Duke. allowing you to utilize the pool facilities and surrounding area during your hire period, you hereby agree to the conditions laid out below. You fully intend and choose to give up the legal rights, as stated below:

1. To waive any and all claims that you have or may have in the future against The Duke. and its owners or representatives, relating to the use of the pool and pool area;
2. To release The Duke. owners and representatives from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury, expense, or other cost that you may suffer or that your next of kin may suffer in connection with your use of the pool and / or pool area to any cause whatsoever, including negligence on the part of the owners or representatives;
3. To hold harmless and indemnify the owners or representatives from any and all liability to property and personal injury, to any third party, resulting from use of the pool or pool area;
4. you can confirm that you are over the age of 18 and that you are responsible for all persons in your group and will adhere to all the rules of the premises;
